## **IMPORTANT DETAILS**

### **WHERE DO WE GO?**

The Saugerties High School is located at 310 Washington Ave. extension. The auditorium is the first building you come to by the parking lot. Please DO NOT park in the bus circle. Please bring your child dressed in the leotard and tights (or shirt and tights/leggings for boys) which they usually wear for class and bring them to their designated seats in the auditorium. Children will be allowed to sit in the theater to watch the show. Boxes with the accessory they will wear will be lined up on the floor of the hallway, backstage. Please wait for the class supervisor to hand out the accessory, and **return it to her/him after the dance.**

### **WHEN DO WE GET THERE?**

**STUDENTS SHOULD ARRIVE** at the school by 1:30, unless they have been instructed to get there earlier by their teacher. Parents who have volunteered to help set up should arrive at 1:00. Parents who will hand out costume accessories should also arrive at 1:00.

## HAIR, MAKE-UP, COSTUMES

Girls must have their hair pulled back and put up (ie: a bun or a French braid). No need to be fancy, just be neat! No bangs for girls in A through D level ballet. Some light make-up may be worn, but nothing heavy is needed. Absolutely no glitter- SHS will not tolerate this!

**PLEASE GET HAIR AND MAKE UP READY AT HOME!**

No jewelry may be worn, and make sure the draw strings on ballet slippers are double knotted and cut off, so nothing messy is hanging out. The ties on tap shoes should be double knotted, or double bowed.

Students should wear the leotard and tights they normally wear for class. They may have been asked to bring an accessory to wear. If not, they will be given a skirt or other accessory to wear for their dance in the show which **MUST BE RETURNED** before leaving the school.

Older students will be allowed to use classrooms for dressing rooms, but they MAY NOT TOUCH ANYTHING in the class room that does not belong to them and they MAY NOT write on the blackboard. There were problems with in past years- if there are problems again, we will not have the privilege of using these classrooms in the future.
