

SBC RECITAL 2021 UPDATE

Our SBC Recital 2021 will be presented at the Kiwanis Ice Arena in Saugerties on Saturday, June 12. It will be presented in 2 Acts, Act 1 starting at 3:00 and Act 2 starting at 4:15. PROTOCOLS AND CAPACITY LIMIT Since students and family members are not all vaccinated, we still need to wear masks, and we also need to distance ourselves in the audience, but the **GOOD NEWS** is that **we can allow 3 family members to attend the show for each student.**

WHICH ACT IS MY CHILD IN? Please refer to the [Order of Show Chart](#) to see if your child will be performing in Act One or Act Two. We have tried to keep siblings, or children that are in multiple classes in the same act, but in a few cases, we were not able to do so. This chart will also give you the length of each dance, which you might find helpful, especially if your child is in more than 1 dance.

WHEN SHOULD WE GET THERE AND WHERE DO WE GO? Students who are dancing in Act One, please arrive by 2:30, and students who are dancing in Act Two, please arrive by 3:45. **Dancers should be performance ready, wearing their class leotard, pink tights and carry their ballet slippers.**

****** Remember, should you need new tights, slippers, etc, that First Street Dancewear carries everything you need at a reasonable price. Customer service is 5 star! Buy local, when you can!******

Hair should be neat and girls should have their hair up. Lyrical students should follow the instructions Justine has given to them. Dancers who are borrowing skirts or accessories will find them in Room G. They will pick them up and go directly to the arena where an area has been set aside for them to watch the show until it is time for them to dance. When they have performed, they will return to their seats until the end of the act and **they must return their accessories before leaving the arena.**

Dancers and families will enter through one door and exit through a separate door. Be sure to visit our beautiful Balloon Arch, compliments of Aubrey Contini, when you leave, to get that special picture!

VOLUNTEERS We will need a few volunteers to help supervise our younger students during the show, help distribute skirts and accessories, collect the accessories before the dancers leave and put them back in the boxes, clean up in general after the show. We also need some muscle to help carry and lay our marley floor. If you think you can help, please [let Scarlett know!](#)

RECORDING OF THE SHOW The performance will be professionally recorded by SARK video. DVDs can be ordered during the last week of classes at the studio, or on the day of the recital. Please download a copy of the [DVD Order Form](#) and bring it with exact cash, or a check made out to SARK video. Cost of the video is \$18.

The show will also be **live-streamed** through Zoom! We will send you a link which you can share with family members who are unable to attend. Only 100 people can attend via Zoom, so please be mindful of how the link will be used (eg- please ask people in 1 location to only join on 1 device).
