

UPDATED PROTOCOL FOR SBC'S WINTER/SPRING SEASON, 2022

IN GENERAL

We will continue with our current schedule for the most part, with some minor changes.

Class size will still be controlled and we will continue to practice safe distancing protocols.

If during the session we have an exposure, or anything else happens that would cause us to have to close our physical space again, we will continue teaching the current schedule of classes virtually.

Class schedule will run for 20 weeks from January 10 through June 11 and tuition will be posted in five 4 week installments. There will be **no increase** in tuition. Tuition is not refundable.

A \$20 Registration Fee will be charged per family for the January-June 2022 season.

All students/parents are asked to register and make payments online to eliminate unnecessary physical contact.

At this time, we are hoping that a spring Recital will be possible. The date we will be targeting is Saturday, June 11. We will begin to investigate possible locations in January and we will keep everyone posted.

IN THE STUDIO

For the safety of our faculty, students and their families, we will continue to follow Saugerties Central School protocols and will continue to require that everyone wears a mask when entering the building, and keep it on at all times until leaving.

Neck gaitors, bandanas, masks with holes, mesh or valves will not be allowed. Cloth face coverings should be made from fabric that cannot be seen through when held up to the light.

Fully vaccinated adult students who choose not to wear a mask must contact the school in advance, provide proof of vaccination and a weekly negative Covid test. Thank you for your cooperation in helping to control the spread of the Delta and Omicron variants and possibly other new covid strains.

The waiting room and dressing rooms will continue to be closed, so students should come dressed and ready to dance. Students will leave their belongings in the waiting room and go directly into the studio.

Parents are asked to drop off children at the door, as we are still trying to minimize the number of people in the building. One parent per student of our Mother Goose Ballet, Pre-Ballet and Adv. Pre-Ballet classes may bring students inside, get them settled and wait inside. We require that parents wear masks inside at all times, even if you are vaccinated, and please maintain a safe distance. In an effort to minimize the number of people in the building, we ask that parents of older students still wait for their children outside.

We will continue to do our best to maintain distance between the dancers when the class moves from barre to center and across the floor. At the end of each class we will clean/disinfect any common areas such as barres, door knobs, etc. Bathrooms will also be wiped down daily.

Air purifiers with a HEPA filter and UV lights will be used as a part of our daily cleaning/disinfecting regiment.
