

## UPDATED SBC PROTOCOLS, MARCH 2022

### IN GENERAL

Class size will still be controlled and we will continue to practice safe distancing protocols.

Class schedule will run for 20 weeks from January 10 through June 11 and tuition will be posted in five 4 week installments. There will be **no increase** in tuition. Tuition is not refundable.

Our spring recital, the SBC 2022 Dance Presentation will be held at the Kiwanis Ice Arena on June 4, 2022, with a dress rehearsal on Friday, June 3. More details about recital fees, dress rehearsal schedules, etc. will be shared as we iron out the details. Classes will continue through June 11.

### IN THE STUDIO

Following the Saugerties Central School guidelines, masks will no longer be required at SBC. We still **strongly encourage wearing masks**, but at this point they are optional for all ages. We want everyone to feel comfortable in making their own choice to feel safe. Thank you for your cooperation and support as we continue to navigate muddy waters.

The waiting room and dressing rooms will **continue to be closed**, so students should come dressed and ready to dance. Students will leave their belongings in the waiting room and go directly into the studio.

Parents are asked to drop off children at the door, as we are still trying to minimize the number of people in the building. One parent per student of our Mother Goose Ballet, Pre-Ballet and Adv. Pre-Ballet classes may bring students inside, get them settled and wait inside. We encourage parents to wear masks inside, but it is optional. Please maintain a safe distance. In an effort to minimize the number of people in the building, we ask that parents of older students still wait for their children outside.

We will continue to do our best to maintain distance between the dancers when the class moves from barre to center and across the floor. At the end of each class we will clean/disinfect any common areas such as barres, door knobs, etc. Bathrooms will also be wiped down daily.

Air purifiers with a HEPA filter are being used as a part of our daily cleaning/disinfecting regiment.
