

UPDATED PROTOCOL FOR SBC'S WINTER/SPRING SEASON, 2023

IN GENERAL

We will continue with our current schedule for the most part, with some minor changes.

Class size will still be controlled and we will continue to practice safe distancing protocols.

If during the session we have an exposure, or anything else happens that would cause us to have to close our physical space again, we will continue teaching the current schedule of classes virtually.

Class schedule will run for 20 weeks from January 9 through June 10 and tuition will be posted in five 4 week installments. There will be **no increase** in tuition. Tuition is not refundable.

A \$20 Registration Fee will be charged per family for the January-June 2022 season. Families who were enrolled in the Fall 2022 season will receive a \$10 discount towards registration.

All students/parents are asked to register and make payments online to eliminate unnecessary physical contact.

At this time, we are hoping that a spring Recital will be possible. The date we will be targeting is Saturday, June 10. We will begin to investigate possible locations in January and we will keep everyone posted.

IN THE STUDIO

For the safety of our faculty, students and their families, we will continue to follow Saugerties Central School protocols. We ask that our parents/students do not attend classes if they are ill in any way. In some cases we may require that students wear a mask. Please contact the school with any questions or issues.

The waiting room and dressing rooms will continue to be closed, so students should come dressed and ready to dance. Students will leave their belongings in the waiting room and go directly into the studio.

Parents are asked to drop off children at the door, as we are still trying to minimize the number of people in the building. One parent per student of our Mother Goose Ballet, Pre-Ballet and Adv. Pre-Ballet classes may bring students inside, get them settled and wait inside. In an effort to minimize the number of people in the building, we ask that parents of older students still wait for their children outside unless previous arrangements have been made.

We will continue to do our best to maintain distance between the dancers when the class moves from barre to center and across the floor. At the end of each class we will clean/disinfect any common areas such as barres, door knobs, etc. Bathrooms will also be wiped down daily.

Air purifiers with a HEPA filter will be used as a part of our daily cleaning/disinfecting regiment.
