

## UPDATED POLICIES AND PROTOCOLS FOR SBC'S FALL SEASON, 2024

### IN GENERAL

Our **2024 Fall Season** of classes will run for 14 weeks from September 9 through December 21 and tuition will be posted in 4 monthly installments. **A \$10 late fee will be charged for payments received more than 8 days past the due date.**

A **\$20 Registration Fee** will be charged per family for the 2024 Fall season. All students/parents are asked to **register** and **make payments** online via their parent portal.

All SBC students are required to follow the dress code for their class; dress code is included in the class description of your portal, or refer to the chart on our web page and your portal.

~ **All students MUST have their hair UP and pulled out of their face!**

**Students in C and D levels must have their hair in a bun.**

~ **Students are NOT permitted to bring cell phones into the studio during classes**

~ **Boxer shorts are NOT permitted in ballet class!**

~ **Gum chewing is not permitted in any class!**

Check the **school calendar** in your portal for scheduled school closings. When classes are missed due to illness, or if classes are cancelled due to snow or inclement weather, they may be made up in an alternate class suggested by the teacher. Announcement of cancellation of classes will be made on the school voice mail, facebook, instagram and saugertiesballet.com.

Please label all shoes and clothing. Please check our **Lost and Found** basket for missing items.

Our tentative date for our Winter Recital Saturday, Dec. 21, location TBA. More details will be emailed, as they are confirmed. All students are encouraged but not required to participate.

### SAFETY IN THE STUDIO

To minimize the spread of illness in general, we ask that students, their parents and siblings who are feeling ill stay home and safe.

The waiting rooms and dressing rooms will now be partially open, but we would still like to minimize their use and avoid overcrowding. Dressing rooms will only be open to teaching assistants and older students who take back to back classes and need a place to change.

We will continue to do our best to maintain distance between the dancers during classes. At the end of each class, we will clean/disinfect any common areas such as barres, door knobs, etc. Bathrooms will also be cleaned and disinfected daily.

Air purifiers with a HEPA filter will be used as a part of our daily cleaning/disinfecting regiment.
